Dear friends and neighbors,

2014 was a truly remarkable year due to your continued generosity and commitment to all of us who work and live here in Mecosta County. Mecosta County Community Foundation is proud to be part of the team in Mecosta County who work hard to enhance the lives of all who reside in Mecosta County.

Together we we created four new funds including the Batdorf Safety Net Fund, Babb Ford Scholarship Fund, CranHill Ranch Fund, and Big Rapids Schools Fund. These funds will provide an endless gift of enrichment within our community. These funds bring our total number of funds to 71, which bring our record high net asset total to \$4,617,574 up \$269,746 from 2013. As we begin our 25th year as a Community Foundation we are appreciative of the efforts of those who began this journey with a vision and \$100,000. This past year MCCF was pleased to grant \$12,600 in educational scholarships and over \$25,000 in our spring and fall grants to many deserving organizations doing great work in Mecosta County. Our MCYAC students granted \$12,890 and performed many community services while continuing to learn the value of philanthropy and community leadership.

Together in 2014, MCCF and our Mecosta County non-profit partners set a very lofty goal of raising \$1,000,000 in a single day. We themed this day "Miracle in Mecosta County" knowing it would be quite miraculous to achieve such a goal. We also wanted to honor our veterans living in Mecosta County and created an additional match pool of funds for them. Over 80 veterans showed up to support our community by making donations. Together we were able to generate \$1,039,000 in just 7 hours. I would like to thank all of our non-profit partners, our veterans, our match pool donors, donors who provided event support, and the MCCF board of directors who gave so much of their time and energy to make this Miracle in Mecosta County a reality! The

past 5 Match Day events have generated 20 new endowed funds and raised over \$3,200,000 all of which has stayed 100% in Mecosta County. As importantly, it has fostered a close bond, as a community of folks who recognize the need to take off their respective name badges and work together to accomplish great things. I am proud to be part of this team.

Please note on the next page the faces and names of the Foundation Board of Trustees. They are familiar faces in our community. They work hard to ensure your gifts to this community are managed wisely and with great integrity. It is our hope that we can earn your trust and confidence in us by strengthening our standards, our ethical practices, and perseverance to the reasons MCCF was conceived. I am grateful for the opportunity to serve with these wonderful leaders. Sadly, we said goodbye to several of our board members, Stephanie Woodworth, Patsy Eisler, John Norton, and Karl Linebaugh. Each of these board members made significant contributions to the Foundation and we thank them. Karl Linebaugh was one of the founding fathers of MCCF and served for 25 years. Please see the inside back cover for more on Karl. We also welcomed two new board members – Laura Rhoades of the Pioneer Group and Kim vonKronenberger from Chemical Bank. Both Laura and Kim will add value to our team.

In closing, my term as the MCCF President has come to the end. Deb Patterson will now take the lead as our foundation President. Deb has served for many years on our board and we are looking forward to her direction and leadership. I intend to remain on the board and continue serving in any capacity asked. It has been a privilege to work with all of you. We have accomplished much together.

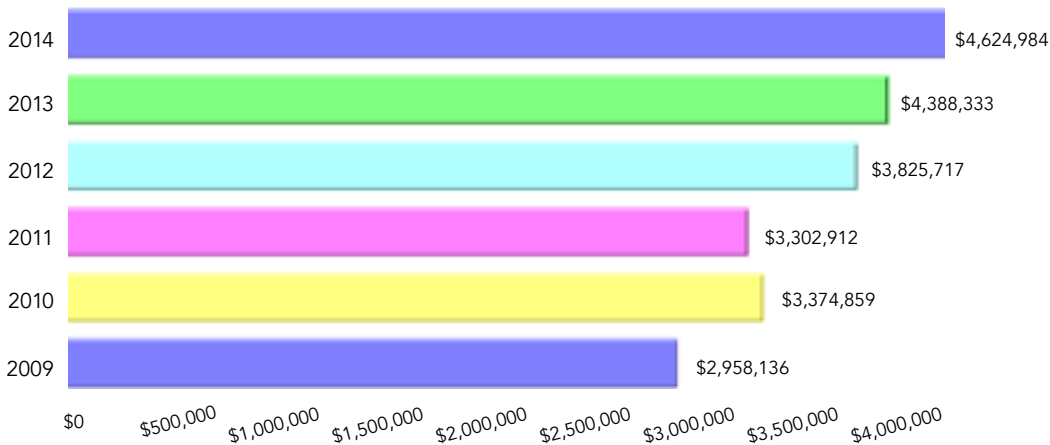

Ensuring that our community's needs are addressed is a top priority for the Community Foundation Grants Committee. Each year in April and October, the committee awards grants to Mecosta County nonprofit organizations and those that service the county from the earnings on the Community Needs Fund Endowment. The Mecosta County Youth Advisory Committee (MCYAC) follows the same grant-making schedule.

In 2014, the Grants Committee and MCYAC awarded grants totaling \$41,739 from the earnings of the Community Needs Endowment and the Youth Endowment of Mecosta County. Additionally, throughout the year, other specific endowments make grants totaling approximately another \$90,000.

Our goal is to continue to grow the Community Needs Fund Endowment so that we can have more earnings to award in the form of grants in coming years. This endowment is important to our community as it allows the Foundation to address the greatest needs or current challenges within the community.

The growth plans for the Community Needs Fund Endowment are vital for us to fulfill our mission of giving back and supporting our community.

The council invited Pamela Fleming to speak about the shelter and how many children it houses on a regular basis. The discussion was an eye opener for the students to hear how many children are affected in Mecosta County. The team hopes this event will raise awareness as well as donations that will go directly back to Our Brother's Keeper shelter.

Miracle in Mecosta County

November 10 was truly a miracle day in Mecosta County. The Mecosta County Community Foundation set a lofty goal of raising \$1 million in seven hours for local charities and organizations. Not only did they reach that goal, it was exceeded by \$39,000. The 2014 Match Day set an all-time record and exceeded 2013's total by \$116,000!

It was a day to support our local non-profit organizations and a day to honor our veterans through special tributes and opening the event with a color guard ceremony. Current and former serviceman and women were eligible to have their donations matched.

"This year's Match Day happened to also be Veteran's Day," said Deb Patterson, Match Day Chair. "We wanted to do something special for those who served or are currently serving our country by matching their donations. Throughout the day, more than 80 veterans were acknowledged for their service."

Throughout the day, hundreds of people

came in and out of the event supporting the 65 nonprofit organizations and 71 endowment funds in Mecosta County. By the end of the evening, four new funds were introduced – the Babb Ford Scholarship, the Wheatland Music Organization Endowment, the Cran-Hill Ranch Endowment and the Batdorff Safety Net.

"It was amazing to see this community pull together and reach a goal that many thought was impossible," said Tim Zehr, foundation president. "I knew it could be done. It is amazing what this area can achieve when working together. And, every dollar raised will stay right here in Mecosta County."

Additional prizes were given to non-profits throughout the day including those that had the best themed booth.

All donations to non-profit charities and to endowed funds within the foundation were matched with funds raised from a \$100,000 match pool (\$10,000 Veterans match pool).
